We accept items that meet the following standards:

- Due to complex medical conditions of our children, all donated items must be **NEW**. We are unable to accept used items of any kind.
- **Stuffed Animals and Toys** must have the following information on the label/package:
Complies with ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) F963
- Toys **CANNOT** have detachable buttons, rhinestones, metal or vinyl snaps, zippers, closures or appliques.
- **Art and Crafts** must be have the following information on the label/package:
Conforms to ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) D4236

Toys are collected year-round.
However, we accept toys specific to the holidays up until Dec. 10 to allow our staff and volunteers time to sort and wrap each gift.
